After signing with Asylum Records, his debut album, +, was released in September 2011 and topped the UK Albums Chart.

ROYAL HONORS AND PERSONAL LIFE

On December 7, 2017, Sheeran was made a member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire for his services to music and charity. After receiving the honor from Prince Charles, Sheeran gushed about the occasion, but also noted it was bittersweet: "My grandfather ... he died on this day four years ago, so it's actually quite a nice full circle thing," he said, according to the prince's Twitter account. "I guess he'd be pretty proud."

SHAPE OF YOU SONG



Shape - A **shape** is the form of an object or its external boundary, outline, or external surface, as opposed to other properties such as color, texture or material type.

Shots - a small amount of a strong alcoholic drink

Jukebox - a machine in a bar, etc. that plays recorded music when a coin is put into it

Grab - to take hold of something or someone suddenly and roughly

Waist - the part of the body above and slightly narrower than the hips

Lead - to control a group of people, a country, or a situation

Bedsheets - a sheet that you put on a bed, that you sleep either on top of or underneath

Thrifty - showing a careful use of money, especially by avoiding waste

Backseat - the seat behind the front seat of a car

Handmade - made using the hands rather than a machine

Follow - to move behind someone or something and go where he, she, or it goes
